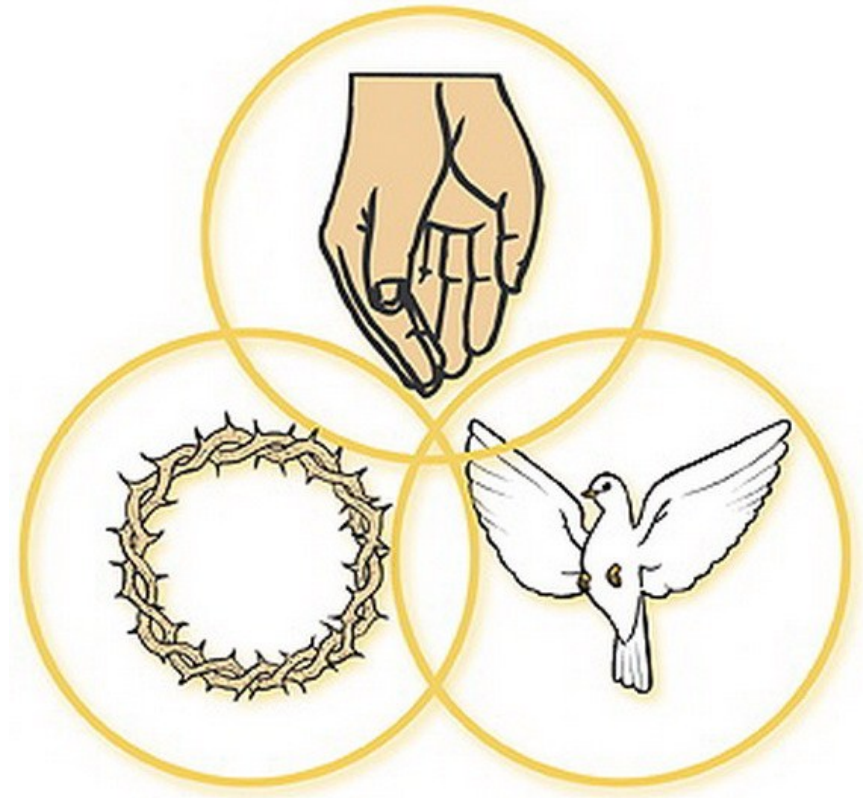

John W. Reeve, Ph.D., is assistant professor of church history at the SDA Theological Seminary at Andrews University. He teaches primarily early church, middle ages and reformation history. John is also editor of *Andrews University Seminary Studies* and co-author of a book on *The Trinity*.



Jon Paulien, Ph.D., is professor of new testament and dean of the School of Religion at LLU since 2007. He is the author of over 25 books, more than a hundred articles, scholarly papers, and other publications. Jon is a specialist in the study of the Gospel of John and Book of Revelation and the intersection of faith with contemporary culture.



Gilbert M. Valentine, Ph.D., is professor of Leadership and Administration at La Sierra University where he also serves as a department chair. He has worked as a pastor, church administrator, and educator in his native New Zealand and Australia, as well as in the worldwide mission field. He is the author of several books on Adventist history.



Richard Rice, Ph.D., is a professor on the faculty of the School of Religion at Loma Linda University. He has served as a pastor in the Southeastern California Conference, and joined the faculty of LLU in 1974. He has a special interest in the doctrine of God and theology of suffering and has authored several books on Christian theology, including the *Reign of God*, a main textbook for Adventist colleges.
